

Letter from Alexander Graham Bell to Marian Bell Fairchild, February 15, 1901

DICTATED. Volta Bureau, Feb. 15, 1901. My dear little girl: —

The Photophone has come of age — it is twenty-one years since I first heard articulate speech produced by a beam of light. And this reminds me that you — our photophone in the truest and highest sense — came into existence at the same time, and I therefore write to show you that I have not forgotten the anniversary of the day that brought so much light and happiness to us all.
